Appendix 2 to the Regulations of Visiting of the Centre for the Documentation of the Art of Tadeusz Kantor CRICOTEKA in Cracow

Recommendations for visitors in the building of Tadeusz Kantor's Gallery - Studio, 7/5 Sienna St. in Cracow

To minimise the risk of exposure to coronavirus, Cricoteka has adopted the following access policy, in accordance with the state regulations as well as the current guidelines of the Chief Sanitary Inspector:

- 1. Visiting the Gallery Studio is possible only by reservation, at least 1 day prior to the date of visit, by phone: +48 572 057 740 or email: rezerwacje@cricoteka.pl.
- 2. The maximum number of visitors in the Gallery Studio at any one time is limited to 1 person, with the exception of:
 - a. parents and children under 13;
 - b. persons living together or forming a joint household.

The total number of visitors cannot exceed 4 people.

- 3. All persons inside the Gallery Studio must cover their mouths and noses.
- 4. The usage of hand sanitizer is recommended upon entering and leaving the Gallery Studio. Hand sanitizer is provided by Cricoteka.
- 5. The entry to the exhibition is free and no tickets are required.
- 6. Printed materials available in the building, i.e. free brochures, maps and leaflets, should not be placed back on the stands after use. Visitors are asked to take these items with them or place them in the designated container situated near the exit.
- 7. We rely on our visitors' responsible attitude and ask that people with any symptoms of infection or elevated body temperature, as well as those taking antipyretics (e.g. paracetamol, ibuprofen), refrain from visiting the museum and undertaking any activity in other public spaces.
- 8. Due to the temporary inaccessibility of the cloakroom and lockers, coats and bags must be carried while visiting the exhibition.
- 9. Visitors should avoid touching communal surfaces such as handrails, walls, glass panes and other construction elements.
- 10. Eating and drinking is not permitted inside the Gallery Studio.
