

Appendix 4 to the Regulations of Visiting of the Centre for the Documentation of the Art of Tadeusz Kantor CRICOTEKA in Cracow

Recommendations for the participants in the events with an audience participation, taking place in the building of Cricoteka, 2-4 Nadwiślańska St. in Cracow

To minimise the risk of exposure to coronavirus, Cricoteka has adopted the following access policy, in accordance with the state regulations as well as the current guidelines of the Chief Sanitary Inspector:

1. While on Cricoteka's premises, all participants must cover their mouths and noses with masks, face shields or other means of protection until further notice.
2. All participants must use hand sanitizer upon entering the building and during the event, according to the needs and general sanitary guidelines. Hand sanitizer is available by the entrance, as well as inside the Theatre Hall, Educational Hall and Conference Room, and - for the duration of events - in the square outside of the building.
3. The maximum number of visitors cannot exceed:
 - a. 60 people in the Theatre Hall
 - b. 15 people in the Educational Hall.

Depending on the type of the event, these limits can also apply to the organizers, performers and technical staff. Please follow the instructions of the staff members in charge of regulating the number of people in these locations.

4. A safe distance of at least 2 metres should be kept between people during the entire visit, with the exception of:
 - a. parents and children under 13;
 - b. persons living together or forming a joint household;
 - c. persons with disabilities, those who cannot move on their own, people with special education needs statement and their caregivers.
5. Seats for audience members will be allocated at a safe distance (every second seat). Audience members must observe this distance for the entire duration of the performance.
6. Eating and drinking is not permitted inside the building, with the exception of the museum café.
7. It is not permitted to leave one's personal belongings in the cloakroom.
8. Visitors may use the restrooms inside the building, which are regularly disinfected, according to a schedule agreed upon with the cleaning staff guaranteeing sanitation safety.

9. Visitors must adhere to the sanitary guidelines displayed in individual rooms in the form of written recommendations and infographics.
10. The usage of elevators is permitted only for persons with disabilities and their care-givers, senior persons and families with children in strollers. Other participants should use the staircase.
11. In narrow spaces where keeping the safe distance is difficult, such as staircases, follow the instructions provided.
12. Visitors should avoid touching communal surfaces such as handrails, walls, glass panes and other construction elements.
13. We rely on our visitors' responsible attitude and ask that people with any symptoms of infection or elevated body temperature, as well as those taking antipyretics (e.g. paracetamol, ibuprofen), refrain from visiting Cricoteka and undertaking any activity in other public spaces.
